



# Wells City Archers Beginners Course

Dates	
Times	<p>The course starts at 6.30pm, so if you can arrive a little earlier that would be helpful.</p> <p>The session will finish at around 8.30pm</p>
Location	<p>The archery indoor range is in the sports club ground in Rowdens Road, Wells, BA5 1TU. From the car park look across the open football field and you will see a white building – between the tennis club and the netball court.</p> <p>What three words is: envoy.emptied.animated</p> <p>Although there are floodlights for the sports pitches, these may be switched off before the end of our session, so you may wish to bring a torch with you.</p>
Clothing	<p>The temperature in the indoor range can be unpredictable. Please wear clothing that is suitable for a range of temperatures – it is best to wear several thin layers rather than big, thick jumpers.</p> <p>Ideally wear clothing that is fairly close fitting around torso and arms with no pockets on the chest.</p> <p>Shoes should be close toed and flat.</p> <p>Tie back long hair and avoid wearing scarves.</p>
Jewellery	<p>Avoid large earrings/necklaces.</p> <p>Please remove any facial piercings on the side of your face where you will be drawing the string (ie right side if you are right handed).</p> <p>If you have any body piercings, remove them from the bow side of your body (ie left side if you are right handed)</p>
Archery equipment	<p>We will provide you with all the equipment that you will need.</p>
Refreshments	<p>We will provide tea and coffee (and usually biscuits). Please bring anything else you may require.</p>
Juniors	<p>Anyone under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian who must stay for the duration of the course.</p>
