



Guidance on buying your first archery set up

Borrow club equipment for a couple of months. When you are ready to purchase, visit a shop rather than buying online.

- Get the riser that feels the best to you – try several. Spend your money here.
- Limbs should be easy to pull – if it takes effort, go for a lighter poundage (no more than 24lb). Choose budget limbs for your first set.
- Hoyt super pro rest.
- Tip to tip stringer.
- Comfortable armbracer.
- Platform finger tab (not glove).
- Biggest bag with the most pockets that you like.
- Quiver with pockets.
- Bowstand.
- Sight – if you get a cheaper one, you will buy a more expensive one later. The cheap one will be fine for a while.
- Arrows – 8 budget arrows to match your poundage/draw length. Leave them uncut. You will buy more later.
